

Terms & Conditions for IOQM Registration

Effective Date: 01/06/2026

Please read these Terms & Conditions carefully before registering for the Indian Olympiad Qualifier in Mathematics (IOQM). By applying for registration, the student and/or parent/legal guardian agree to be bound by these Terms & Conditions.

1. Eligibility

1. Registration for IOQM is subject to the eligibility criteria prescribed by the Mathematics Teachers' Association (India) and the agencies governing the Indian Olympiad Programme.
2. Submission of a registration form does not automatically guarantee eligibility or participation.
3. MTA(I) reserves the right to reject, suspend, or cancel any registration found to be in violation of the prescribed eligibility requirements.

2. Accuracy of Information

1. The applicant is responsible for ensuring that all information provided during registration is accurate, complete, and up to date.
2. Any incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or fraudulent information may result in rejection or cancellation of registration without notice.
3. MTA(I) may seek additional documents or clarification for verification purposes.

3. Registration and Examination Administration

1. Registration shall be considered complete only upon successful submission of the application and payment of the prescribed registration fee, where applicable.
2. MTA(I) reserves the right to verify registration details and allocate examination centres based on administrative and operational requirements.
3. Examination centres, schedules, instructions, and procedures may be modified if required due to operational, administrative, legal, technical, or unforeseen circumstances.

4. Fees and Payments

1. Registration fees, if applicable, shall be paid only through authorized payment channels.
2. Refunds and cancellations shall be governed exclusively by the published Refund/Cancellation Policy.
3. MTA(I) shall not be responsible for payment failures, banking delays, gateway interruptions, or issues arising from third-party payment systems.

5. Candidate Responsibilities

1. Candidates must comply with all examination instructions, rules, and guidelines issued by MTA(I).
2. Candidates are responsible for preserving the confidentiality of login credentials, registration details, and examination-related communications.
3. Candidates shall ensure that all required documents and information are submitted within the prescribed timelines.

6. Unfair Means and Misconduct

1. Any form of malpractice, impersonation, unauthorized assistance, cheating, use of prohibited materials, falsification of records, or misconduct is strictly prohibited.
2. MTA(I) reserves the right to cancel candidature, withhold results, disqualify participants, or take any other appropriate action in cases of suspected or confirmed misconduct.
3. Decisions of MTA(I) regarding examination conduct, disciplinary matters, and eligibility shall be final and binding.

7. Website and Portal Usage

1. Users shall not attempt to gain unauthorized access to the registration portal, examination systems, databases, or related infrastructure.
2. Users shall not upload malicious software, interfere with system operations, or engage in activities that may affect the integrity, security, or availability of the platform.
3. MTA(I) reserves the right to restrict access to any user found misusing the portal.

8. Privacy and Data Protection

1. Collection, processing, storage, and sharing of personal information shall be governed by the IOQM Privacy Policy.
2. By registering for IOQM, the applicant and parent/legal guardian acknowledge that they have read and understood the Privacy Policy.
3. Consent provided during registration shall be deemed valid for examination administration and related activities as described in the Privacy Policy.

9. Intellectual Property

1. All examination materials, question papers, website content, logos, trademarks, and related intellectual property belong to the respective owners and are protected by applicable laws.
2. Reproduction, distribution, publication, or commercial use of examination materials without prior written permission is prohibited.

10. Limitation of Liability

1. MTA(I) shall make reasonable efforts to ensure smooth conduct of registration and examination processes.
2. MTA(I) shall not be liable for delays, interruptions, technical failures, force majeure events, internet disruptions, payment gateway failures, or circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

11. Amendments

1. MTA(I) reserves the right to modify, update, revise, or withdraw these Terms & Conditions at any time.
2. Updated versions shall be published on the official website and shall become effective from the date of publication.

12. Governing Authority

1. The administration and conduct of IOQM shall be governed by the rules, policies, and directions issued by MTA(I) and the agencies responsible for the Indian Olympiad Programme.
2. The decisions of MTA(I) in matters relating to registration, eligibility, examination conduct, evaluation, results, and participation shall be final and binding.
3. **Governing Law:** These Terms and Conditions, and any disputes, claims, or controversies arising out of or related to the Indian Olympiad Qualifier in Mathematics (IOQM) registration process, shall be governed by, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of India, without regard to its conflict of law principles.
4. **Exclusive Jurisdiction:** Any legal action, suit, or proceeding arising out of or relating to these Terms and Conditions or the candidate's registration for the IOQM shall be instituted exclusively in the competent courts situated in Mumbai, Maharashtra. By submitting the registration application, the applicant (and their parent or legal guardian, where applicable) irrevocably consents to the exclusive jurisdiction of such courts and waives any objection to the venue of any such proceeding.
